HISTORY AND PURPOSE OF LIFE FOUNDATION

Life Foundation, Inc. was established in 1970 and approved by the IRS as a non-profit organization. Its Lasting Purpose is serving humanity is threefold: (1) to relieve the suffering of men, women and children through chiropractic healthcare; (2) to educate the general public in the value of chiropractic care; (3) to conduct a continuing program of research and study in the field of chiropractic.

In addition to publishing educational materials, Life Foundation Sponsors a Mobile Health Unit which gives free chiropractic care to anyone who comes to us with health problems. Patients receive consultation, X-ray, examination and adjustment from a staff of professional chiropractors who are dedicated.

Now, Life Foundation's first major goal is at hand: the all-important project designed to fulfill the long cherished dream of building a college of chiropractic — Life Chiropractic College.

WHAT IS LIFE CHIROPRACTIC COLLEGE?

Plans are underway to build a complete educational facility with classrooms, laboratories, an auditorium, a library, an out-patient clinic, a cafeteria, dormitories and administrative offices. At the present time, has available a large, modern building of 36,000 square feet. A nearby complex of apartments might also be converted to on-campus housing for students.

Life Foundation is striving for its first enrollment of 600 students in the fall of 1975. The schedule will be organized into day and night sessions of 300 students each.

Chiropractic curriculum is aimed towards the specialized education of a college graduate with a BA degree or a two-year certificate. Our course of study will include over 500 class hours each in anatomy, physiology, diagnosis, clinic and chiropractic technique. Each student will also undergo extensive training in chemistry, pathology, bacteriology, neurology, X-ray, psychiatry, obstetrics and gynecology, and hygiene.

To further prepare our students for the practice of chiropractic and to install the principles on which we base our Lasting Purpose of service to humanity, classes in chiropractic philosophy, principle and practice, public speaking and ethics and jurisprudence will be taught. A faculty of 15 full-time and 15 part-time accredited teachers and chiropractors will conduct the classes.

Another very important part of the school will be the extension of Life Foundation's present chiropractic Mobile Health Unit service. With more facilities, that is, additional mobile units, more people who badly need the aid of chiropractic will be reached.

Equally important is the fact that the mobile units will be used for residency requirements for graduates of Life Chiropractic College. Such mobile units can provide a ready facility for field work all over the world. It will be possible to send help to other countries where chiropractic care is virtually unknown, but where many suffering individuals are hoping and praying for a miracle of relief.

Making chiropractic health service available throughout the world is a top priority of Life Foundation. But first, we must establish Life Chiropractic College. It is the essential first step if our dreams and the dreams of thousands of other dedicated chiropractors and laymen are to be realized.

THE FUTURE

The long-range plan of Life Foundation is to establish a self-sufficient community, literally, a City of Life with living and working facilities for both young and old. The blueprints are ready. They provide for a children's home, living quarters for young people and students, a farm, residences for senior citizens, offices and stores.

Within the nurturing atmosphere of the City of Life, residents will be living the principles we espouse. Students will experience the inherent, self-motivating quality of abundant giving and serving. They will be imminently prepared to go out into the world and perpetuate the Lasting Purpose of unselfish service to humanity.
